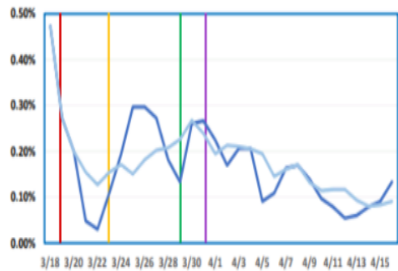

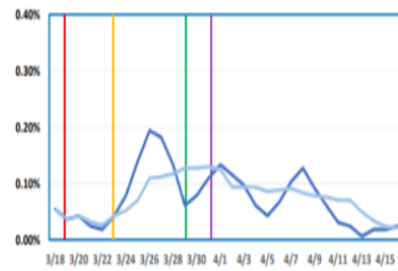

Rolling Average - Quarantine as Percent of Workforce

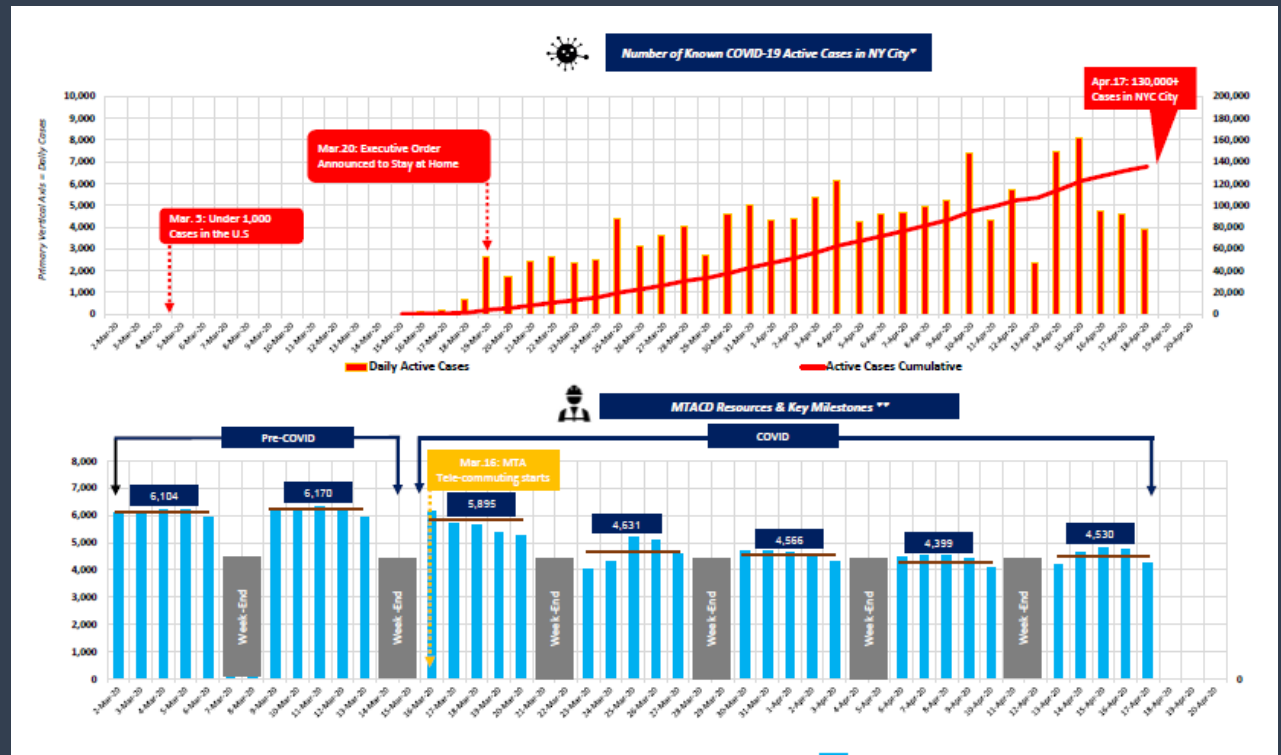

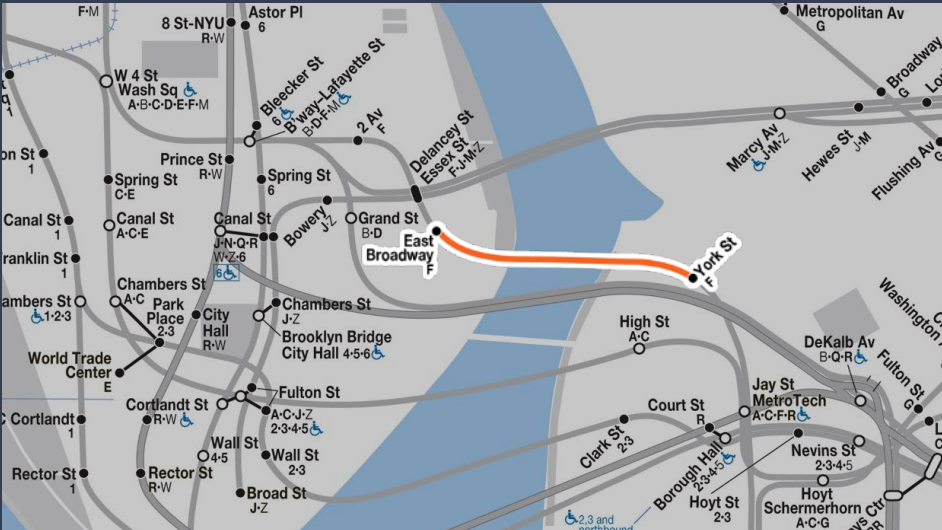

All over the region, MTA workers and our contractors are replacing switches, upgrading power systems, and generally keeping the system humming. On MTA construction sites, Personal Protective Equipment and cleaning supplies are typically provided by the contractors. But because masks, gloves, disinfectant, and sanitizer have been in short supply—and because they are so essential to keeping our 250+ worksites safe—the MTA has supplemented contractors' provisions with our own over the last several weeks.

Since mid-March, Director of Real Estate Operations David Soliman has secured 100,000 surgical masks and 25,000 pairs of gloves for C&D construction sites. Despite the national shortage of those materials, David working with MTA Procurement found a small distributor in Jamaica, Queens, to supply the gloves and a distributor in Port Washington, Long Island, to supply the masks. He's also distributing 6,500 N95 respirators provided to us by New York State. Resourceful!
